

The alternative route (3.30 pm – 6.00pm) is via George Square, Kellands Road, Davah Road as shown on the attached plan.

Access for Emergency Vehicles will be maintained at all times.
Access for pedestrians will be maintained and vehicular access to affected properties will be maintained whenever possible.
Site notices will be erected in due course indicating the temporary restriction to traffic and the alternative routes where applicable.

On the dates stated below, Roads Department are planning to implement the following traffic management:

Traffic Management for A96 Clovenstone to Thainstone

- Friday 26th November 19:30 to Monday 29th November 06:30 – 24 Hour Road Closure for the full weekend. ***Signed diversions will be in place.***

Residential access and egress will always be maintained during construction works; a resident's access will be installed at the start of the works. Residents will be asked to wait in a holding area before being conveyed through site safely. Consultation letters will be provided to notify residents of the times of restricted access.

A wide load protocol will be in place prior to the works, this will be sent on when a traffic management contractor is in place.

The safety of maintenance workers remains a top priority during this essential maintenance project. Physical distancing protocols, in line with Scottish Government guidance, will be in place to ensure all on site personnel remain safe throughout the duration of the project. Thorough risk assessments will be carried out and cleansing stations will be implemented on site to ensure all staff remain safe.
